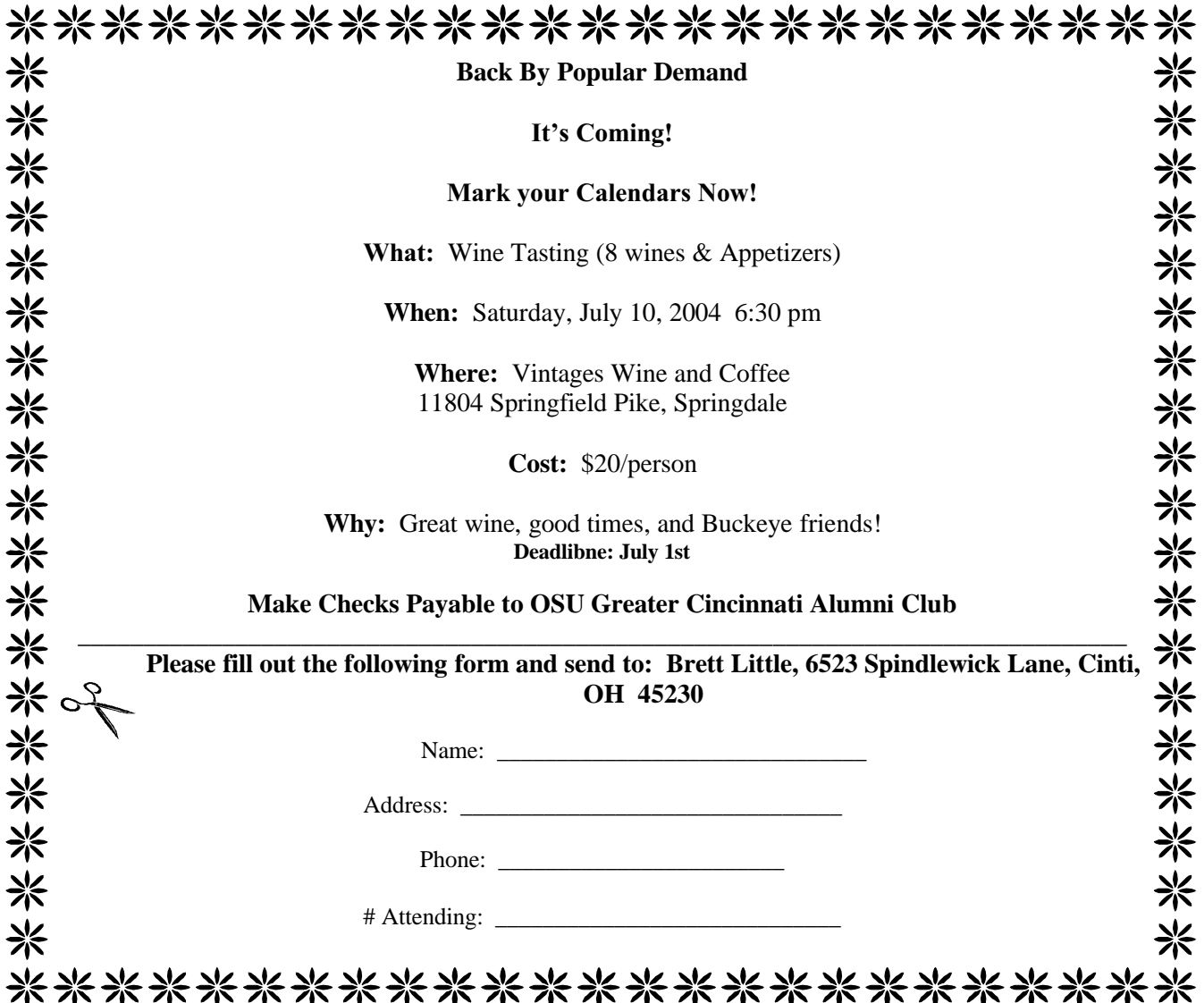

### **OSU Greater Cincinnati Endowment Scholarship**

Dear Alumni and Friends of Ohio State,

As you are probably well aware, the cost of football tickets has skyrocketed for the 2004-05 season. The greater Cincinnati Alumni Association has held a tailgate party for almost 20 consecutive years. With rising costs such as tickets and catering, we feel that we are at a crossroads. We would like to continue to have the tailgate. It develops friendships in the club as well as a good reason to see our local members on an annual basis. However, we also have had a decline at this annual event which we feel has become cost prohibitive for some. On this note, we would like you to either e-mail your responses or drop a line to Cheryl Hatch, our Tailgate Chairperson to let us know how you feel about continuing the tailgate and to what level you would like to continue.

1. The cost of a ticket this fall will be \$60.00 We are hoping for either UC or Marshall tickets. Schmidt's has done our catering for the past few years. Would you like to continue with Schmidts? The cost would be approximately \$20/person for food and drinks.
2. Do you think \$20/person on top of the ticket price is too much? Would you like a more casual get together? Chips, pretzels, coke and beer for approximately \$10/person?
3. Would you like to do away with the tailgate? (Tickets will not be available without the tailgate)
4. Can you think of any ideas to keep the tailgate at a reasonable cost?

\*\*Any money that the tailgate generates goes directly in our scholarship fund. This fund helps us give local students in the area scholarships to attend Ohio State.

Many of you I'm sure remember when we had our tailgate at Drake Union Shelter House every year. The club had to pay \$30.00 to rent the shelter house and then had to bring in our own caterers when management changed. The cost of renting the same shelter house is now \$800/per event. \$400 for Alumni groups! We now have a new home on the Ag campus, by the gazebo. It is close walking distance to the stadium, restrooms, and also parking (if you get there early!).
